### DRINKING FROM THE CUP

Because of the highly contagious nature of the flu virus, the cup of the Lord's Blood will not be offered during Mass until the flu season has passed. While it is regrettable that we

are not able to offer the Eucharist under the signs of both bread and wine, please be assured that in receiving the Eucharist under the sign of the bread, one receives both the Body and Blood of Christ. Eucharistic Ministers who are assigned to minister the Cup will minister the Sacred Body of Christ instead.

We will continue to refrain from shaking hands at the sign of peace in order to prevent spread of the flu.

### MEDITATION FOR the FEAST of the DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

The anniversary of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, which was erected by the Emperor Constantine, has been observed on this day since the twelfth century. This feast was at first observed only in Rome, but later in honor of the basilica, which is called the mother church of Christendom, the celebration was extended to the whole Latin Church. This action was taken as a sign of devotion to and of unity with the Chair of Peter which, as Saint Ignatius of Antioch wrote, "presides over the whole assembly of charity."
